On February 20, 2025, at South Kazakhstan Medical Academy (SKMA) a lecture by Thomas Notegger, Manager for Production Activities at Polpharma Group was held. He shared insights on introducing automation and AI in pharmaceutical production and discussed SCADA-system operating at Polpharma Santo plant. We give students access to real-world cases, advanced technologies and good practices.



On May 28, 2025, a lecture was delivered at SKMA by Olga Maklakova, Corporate Quality Director of JSC "AKRIKHIN" in the Eurasian Economic Zone.

The topic of the lecture was:

"European Quality

Standards at Polpharma Santo. Deviations and CAPA as Processes of the Pharmaceutical Quality System." During the session, Olga Maklakova elaborated on the implementation and maintenance of EU GMP standards at pharmaceutical enterprises, practices of quality control and management, and the importance of timely detection of deviations and the implementation of corrective and preventive actions (CAPA). Special attention was given to practical case studies from Polpharma Santo and the role of the quality system in ensuring product safety and efficacy. The event sparked strong interest among SKMA students and faculty, making a significant contribution to the professional development of future pharmacists in the region.
